These children are invisible to the mental health system and their needs are being ignored²

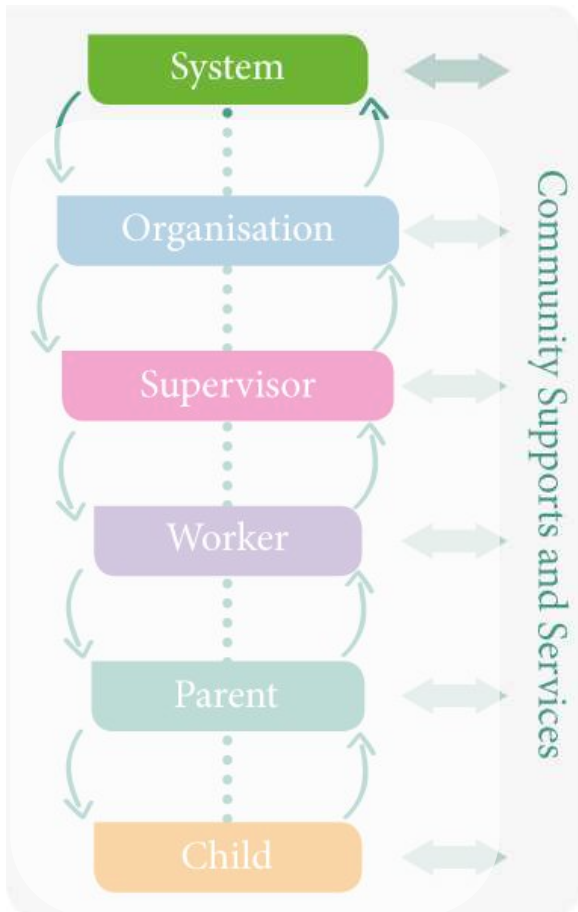
